The NSS committee organized a 7 Day Special Camp from 09-03-2024 to 15-03-2024 at Sawanpura Dhani. The main objectives of the camp were:

- To understand the community in which the students work.
- To identify the needs and problems of the community and involve the students in problem solving.
- To develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.
- To utilize their knowledge in finding practical solution to individual and community problems.
- To improve national integration and social harmony.

A literacy programme was organized for all the seven days under New India Literacy Programme (NILP) in which NSS volunteers promoted literacy programme by providing education to some adults.

DAY-1

Cleanliness programme

The first day of camp was started with the opening ceremony in which the convener of the N.S.S Committee told about the objectives of the activities to be organized in the camp. The Principal addressed the students and motivated them to gain skills in mobilizing community participation. She told that the NSS targets to orient the youth students to community service while they are studying in the college.





After that 'The Cleanliness Programme" was organized on 09-03-2024 at the college campus as well as Dhani Sawanpura. All the staff members and a number of students participated in the activity. With zest and zeal, the enthusiastic students steered the cleanup programme to success through their efforts and the support of the college. At last, the refreshment was distributed. The programme ended with a vote of thanks to students for the initiatives taken by them.



DAY -2

Tree Plantation

Tree Plantation involves planting a large number of trees and seedlings, often for the purpose of environment protection. At the beginning of day 2 (10-03-2024) activity, the NSS Committee Convener told that trees play a significant role in our ecosystem through maintaining balance among elements of nature. Total 43 saplings were planted by the staff and the students. Different saplings were planted like flowers, green tea plant, herbs etc. The saplings were planted within and around the college premises as well as at the Dhani Sawanpura. At the end of the programme, the principal motivated the students by saying that the tree plantation is necessary to save the endangered environment and to beautify our life. We must engage ourselves in environmental protection activities in order to make our own life comfortable.







DAY -3

Child Welfare and Road Safety

Primary School, Dhani Sawanpura. The B.Ed. 1st year student Mahak and Amandeep told about the road safety rules with the help of standard signs and symbols. For the child welfare some stationary items were distributed among 20 students on the basis of need. The students were happy to receive their stationary items. At last, the convener of NSS Committee interacted with school students and wished them bright future. After that the Principal Dr. Rajni Bala inspired the students to follow the safety rules and also aware their friends and family too.

Yoga /Health Awareness Activity

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Environmental Sanitation Activity
